DIVIDE THE RANCHO.

ARNAZ FAMILY'S SHARES.

The referees in the Arnaz estate reported to Judge Bordwell yesterday, and in all probability that report will be the basis upon which the heirs in the estate will receive their inheritance.

The Arnaz lands lie between Los Angeles and Santa Monica and comprise about 700 acres of fine agricultural land, which is valued at about \$140,000. Some time ago a suit was brought by the Senora Maria C. de Arnaz against Louis G. Olivares, Pragades Arnaz de Valla and several others, for a partition of the estate. It was a friendly suit and Judge Trask appointed John Wilfskill, John B. Amestoy and John B. Sanchez as referees to view and agree on a partition of the lands.

Originally the Arnaz lands formed a

part of the Rancho Rincon de Los Bueyes, and the widow was left an undivided seventh of the entire holding. In order to partition the estate it has been necessary for the referees to lay out a public road, so that all the heirs may have access to and from a public road. This has been done, a basis of agreement reached, and it only remains for the court to make the necessary order, based upon the terms of the report.
