M ORE ACREAGE TO BE PLATTED.

NEW SUBDIVISIONS FOR CHOICE HOME SITES.

Werner and Ellis Tracts to be Placed on the Market as Soon as Improvements Contemplated are Completed—Another Part of Arnaz Rancho Sold at an Advance.

J. H. Bohon has secured fifty acres through Althouse Brothers, on the west, side of Figueroa street, south of Florence avenue, for a reported price of: \$28,500, from Fritz, Henry and Oscar Werner, that will be added to his present tract of eighty acres, known as Sunny Side Park addition, that adjoins this latest investment.
