

HOLD SERVICES FOR S. C. WARD

Veteran Realty Man And Lawyer Had Been Active in Civic Affairs

Funeral services for Shirley C. Ward, 68, veteran realty man and attorney, were to be held late today at his home, 795 Holliday road, Pasadena, with burial following in Evergreen Cemetery. The services were to be read by Dr. Josiah Sibley and were to be public, while the interment is private.

Mr. Ward was born in Dickson County, Tenn., came to Southern California with his parents when he was 12 and had been active in civic and business affairs from the time he reached his majority. Educated to the law, he nevertheless branched out early into the real estate field and also became a power in the oil industry.

Among his many accomplishments were a share in financing the Municipal Light and Power Bureau, the creation of the West Seventh street business district and a consolidation of oil interests twenty-three years ago, which saved many producers from extinction and stabilized the entire California oil industry at the time. He was a member of the American, state and county bar associations and of many clubs and civic associations.

He is survived by his widow, four sons and two daughters.
