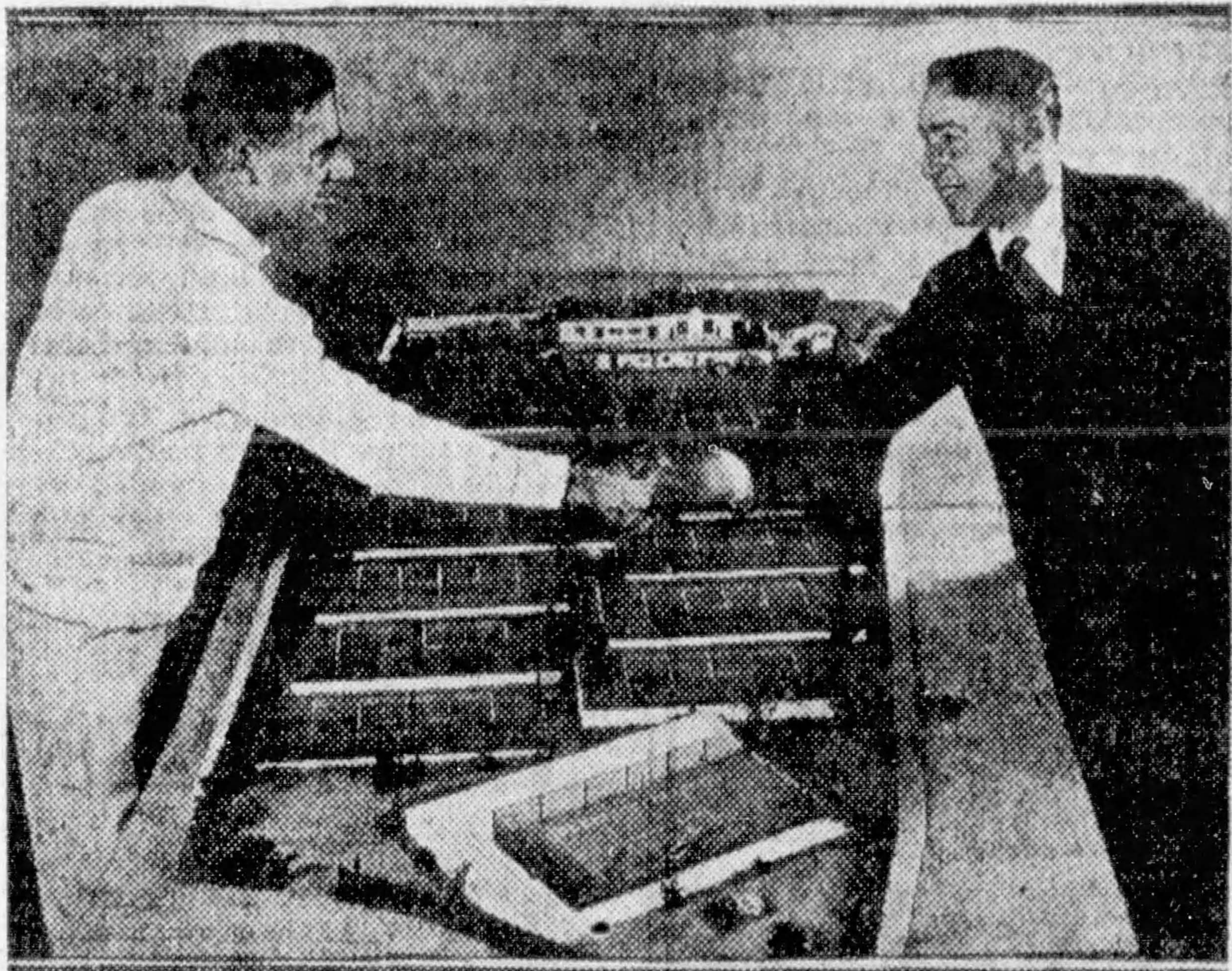


# Tennis Club Planned
