During his career in aerospace, Mr. Titchnell was also instrumental in designing the landing control systems. For the C-5A Galaxy, the L-1011 and NASA's first moon rocket.

An Andrew Felton scholar, Mr. Titchnell held a BA degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Pittsburgh and a Master's in Electrical Engineering from UCLa. He was a veteran of military service with the Army Air Force.  
 Mr. Titchnell's forebears traveled to the first ship to follow the Mayflower from England in the 1600s. He was a Son of the American Revolution.
