

Studio Group May Appeal Denial

Appeal to the Los Angeles City Council on a decision by the Planning Commission denying an application to construct a motion picture studio at 9601 Cattaraugus St. in Los Angeles was predicted today. The application originally was denied by Zoning Administrator Huber E. Smutz and later by the commission.

At the public hearing Joseph Scott, chief counsel for F. J. Frick the applicant, stated the studio would be used largely for the production of educational films and all shooting would be done inside on sound stages.

The application was opposed by Walter H. Leimert; Hal Hughes, representing the California Country Club and several property owners in the area.

The opponents contended that the site lacked ready access and that constant movement of trucks and automobiles would be a source of general nuisance in the residential area.
