Trio Seeks to Buy Lake Tahoe Casino

CARSON CITY, Nev. (A)—Three men have applied to the Nevada Tax Commission to purchase Cal-Neva Lodge, one of Lake Tahoe's biggest gambling casinos.

The prospective owners are Bert M. Grober, Miami Beach, Fla., restaurateur, and Herman and Harold Tracton, Los Angeles businessmen. The purchase price is reportedly about one million dollars.

Cal-Neva, which operates only during summer months, is owned by Sandy Adler. The Internal Revenue Bureau recently filed \$78,000 in tax liens against three gambling establishments owned by Adler.
