## New Chaminade High To Open Here in Fall

A new Catholic high school for boys, Chaminade High School, will be opened this September by the Marianist Brothers and Fathers on the extensive campus now known as Cheviot Hills Military Academy.

Located at 9601 Cattaraugus Ave. just west of Robertson Blvd. in the Cheviot Hills district, the school will open with all four high school grades.

Registration and entrance examinations are scheduled for Sunday, May 11, at 2 p.m. in the school. Resident students will be accepted for the freshman and sophomore years.

### 10-Acre Campus

Main building on the beautifully landscaped, 10-acre campus includes offices, classrooms, dormitory, chapel, library, auditorium and dining hall.

Other buildings provide additional classrooms, laboratories, infirmary, faculty residence, athletic showers and lockers. Athletic facilities include a swimming pool, football field, baseball diamond, basketball and tennis courts.

Brother John Perko, S.M., principal of Chaminade Prep in Santa Cruz, will be the new school's first principal, according to Brother James Wipfield, Marianist supervisor of schools. A native of Cleveland and a graduate of the University of Dayton, Brother John was formerly principal of St. James High School in San Francisco.

### Named for Founder

The Chaminade faculty will also include Father Donald Bracht, S.M., as instructor and chaplain; other Marianist Brothers and two lay teachers.

The new school is named for Father William Joseph Chaminade, founder of the Marianists

and priest-hero of the French Revolution. It will be the fifth to be conducted by the community in California.

Cheviot Hills Military Academy, directed by Frank J. Brick, a Catholic layman, will continue to operate until the end of the present school term.

All inquiries regarding Chaminade High should be made with Brother James Wipfield or Father William Swegar, S.M., at Junipero Serra High School, 14830 S. Van Ness Ave., Gardena (MElo 41118). Registration will be conducted at the Cheviot Hills campus on only the one day, May 11.

Only boarding high school for boys in Los Angeles, Chaminade High is well equipped to accommodate a limited number of resident students in bright and airy double rooms. A small group of Marianist postulants, now at Santa Cruz, will also be in residence at the new school.
