

Country Club Hotel Planned

Plans for a \$2,000,000 country club hotel on the site of the California Country Club, near Culver City, were announced yesterday by the owners, Fred MacMurray, John Wayne, Mitchell Leisen, Frank Borzage and Bo Roos.

If plans are approved by property owners in the vicinity and by zoning officials, the owners said they plan to break ground Jan. 1 for a 270-room hotel, a glass-enclosed clubhouse with roof garden and dining room for 1000 guests, 35 bungalows, tennis courts, swimming pool and a four-story garage.

The construction, expected to take 12 to 18 months, will be on nine acres not now used by the golf course. William Allen and George Lutzi are architects.
