

Work Proceeding On Motor Avenue

Work on the separation and paving of Motor avenue from the Airline tracks to Manning avenue in Palms, is progressing at a very rapid rate, it was announced today by Los Angeles city engineering department heads, and should be completed within a few weeks. The grading is now under way, and with the installation of the viaduct, paving should be completed within the course of two or three months, it was indicated.

The Palms district has been flooded by rains coming through the district from nearby hills and it is with this in mind that the city will also undertake the construction of a storm drain to supplement the one now in use, it was stated. It is expected to terminate at Mentone avenue and National boulevard, however, merely precipitating the waters into a new area, Palms business men declared. The tube is to be two feet in diameter, and is thought by civic leaders to be too small to take care of the water.
