

LOWE'S CORN STAND NOW AT NEW LOCATION ON OVERLAND AVENUE

Forced to move from its old familiar location because of Los Angeles zoning laws, the famed Lowe's Corn Stand opened yesterday in a brand new building at 3016 Overland Ave.

Residents of this area for the past 32 years have patronized Lowe's at their old location at 10537 National Blvd.

At the new location on Overland, a large parking space is now available. Fresh corn is picked every morning from the Lowe fields at Malibu and sold the same day. Holdovers are fed to cattle. In addition to their famous corn, Lowe's carry a stock of fresh seasonal fruits and vegetables.

Ancestors of the present Lowe family were one of the first to settle in the Palms area in the pioneer days.
